KHYS Research Travel Grant

Objective

3-6 month research stay abroad (university or company)

Type of funding

Financial support (travel and living expenses)

Requirements

Accepted as doctoral researcher by your department and member of KHYS

Eva Lichtenberger, Andreas Hahmann – Funding Opportunities for Stays Abroad

- Project abroad must not be a fundamental component of doctoral research but an expansion thereof
- Continued scholarship or employment by the KIT institute/work group during the stay abroad

KHYS Research Travel Grant – Application process

- Call for application
 - Usually twice a year (KHYS infomail, KHYS website)
- **Application documents**
 - Application form (download) (approx. five pages)
 - Information on financing (download) during the stay abroad
 - Assessment by main supervisor
 - Letter of invitation from the applicant's cooperation partner
 - CV and degree certificates
 - Letter of acceptance as a doctoral reseacher from the applicant's department

KHYS Research Travel Grant – Application process

- Approval procedure
 - KHYS selection committee decides within short time after the deadline
- Funding criteria
 - Compliance with the eligibility requirements
 - Expected added value of the research stay abroad (for the (post)doctoral research work, the applicant and the KIT working group)
 - Previous scientific achievements
 - Previous publications
 - Prizes, awards, and contributions to conferences, if applicable
 - Grades of degree and, if applicable, doctoral degree
 - Assessment by main supervisor (i.e. person authorized to administer doctoral examinations)



KHYS Research Travel Grant – Funding Procedure

- The maximum funding amount will be determined by KHYS. The amount granted is based on the support rates for doctoral researchers of the DAAD
- Payment in advance about four weeks before the start of the journey.
- Subject of funding:
 - Airport transfer costs within Germany (local public transport, German train services with "Deutsche Bahn"; car travel costs will only be accepted in exceptional cases for which reasons must be specified)
 - Return flight
 - Accommodation and subsistence costs (lump sum) at the place of destination

Eva Lichtenberger, Andreas Hahmann – Funding Opportunities for Stays Abroad

- Funding is not provided for:
 - Fees for visa, tuition fees and any other kind of fees
 - Insurances
 - Transfer and other trips at destination, rental car
 - Participation in conferences





KHYS Research Travel Grant – Funding Procedure

- **Obligations Following the Research Stay Abroad**
 - At the latest four weeks after return from the stay abroad, the official travel application form will be completed in a personal meeting at KHYS upon presentation of the original receipts and documents.

- Submission of a final report (download) on the research stay abroad
- If the research stay abroad funded by KHYS contributes towards a publication, KHYS must be informed of this and appropriate reference to the funding received from KHYS must be added to the acknowledgement in the publication.
- The statement "The research stay abroad was funded by Karlsruhe House of Young Scientists (KHYS)" should be included in the acknowledgement of the doctoral thesis.

Objective

- Starting workshop
- Travel expenses grant (maximum of EUR 1,500)

Requirements

- International contact
- Contact must be new for the doctoral researcher and his or her working group

KHYS Networking Grant – Overview

Supported Activities

- Stay(s) abroad with up to two different new and international contacts for up to two weeks per contact
 - Visit at a researcher renowned in applicant's area of expertise in relation to doctoral research project
 - Preparation of a longer research period abroad

Scope of funding

- Up to EUR 1,500 for travel and accommodation costs
- Kick-off workshop "Strategies for Establishing International Contacts"

Prerequisite:

Contact must be <u>international</u> and <u>new</u> for applicant and their research group

KHYS Networking Grant – Process

- Call for application
 - Usually twice a year (KHYS infomail, KHYS website)
 - Travel must take place within the given funding period
- **Application requirements:**
 - Doctoral researcher at KIT and officially accepted by your KIT department
 - Member of KHYS
 - Idea whom you want to contact
 - The destination needs to be located outside of Germany
 - The kick-off workshop can then help you figure out how to realize these plans.

- The contact has to be a new one for you/your working group.
- Participation at the kick-off workshop is mandatory



KHYS Networking Grant – Process

- **Application documents:**
 - Application form [downloads]
 - CV
 - Certificate and Transcript of Records (Diploma or Master)
 - Letter of reference by your supervising professor
 - Letter of acceptance as a doctoral researcher by your KIT department

KHYS Networking Grant – Procedure

- **Selection process and Grant Approval**
 - KHYS selection committee decides within short time after the deadline
 - Mandatory participation in a one-day workshop where you will work collectively on several strategies how to establish international contacts and networks effectively.
 - Contact to the respective researcher or working group and planning of the trip
 - First appointment at KHYS four weeks before the trip for application of the travel subsidy (EUR 1,500)
 - Subject of funding:
 - Travel and accomodation
 - Visa charges, if applicable
 - No funding for daily allowances or conferences

KHYS Networking Grant – Procedure

- **Obligations Following Stay Abroad**
 - **Final accounting** within 8 weeks after the trip (second appointment) at KHYS)
 - **Repayment:** In case the travel expenses add up to less than the maximum of EUR 1,500, you will receive a reclaim of KHYS of the respective remaining amount.
 - **Final report:** After the receipt of the final calculation you have to hand in a final report within four weeks. [downloads]

Overview

Funding for research stays abroad

- DAAD Research Grant for Doctoral Researchers
- German-American Fulbright Commission <u>program for doctoral researchers</u> (4-6 months)
- Etc. → see overview on KHYS website

Funding for travels to conferences

- DAAD Program for travels to conferences
 - Currently no applications possible!
- Other grants for materials and travel expenses → see overview on KHYS website



DAAD – Research Grant For Doctoral Researchers (1 to 12 months)

Funding:

- Monthly rates and the travel allowance vary by destination country
- Health, accident and personal liability insurance
- A flat -rate allowance for research and congress expenses (EUR 102/month)
- Tuition fees and additional travel expenses can be partially covered as well as child-care costs

Application deadlines 2023:

March 15, 2023, selection decision May/June, start of grant beginning in August 2023, June 15, 2023, selection deadline September / October, grant start in November 2023



German-American Fulbright Commission – Doctoral Program

- 4 to 6-month stays in the USA
- **Funding:**
 - Monthly flat-rate allowance of EUR 1,700
 - Fixed travel allowance of EUR 1,400
 - One-time lump sum for incidental costs in the amount of EUR 300
 - Health and accident insurance for the USA
 - Fulbright J-1 visa free of charge
- **Application Deadlines:**
 - June 1 and November 1 every year



Participation in conferences (poster presentation/lecture)

Eva Lichtenberger, Andreas Hahmann – Funding Opportunities for Stays Abroad

- Funding from institute
- Funding from external sources for conference trips/travel expense allowances
 - DAAD Program for travels to conferences > currently no applications possible
 - FAZIT-STIFTUNG <u>Travel expense allowances</u> (application in German; 6 weeks in advance)
