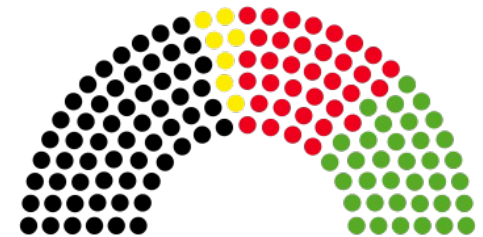

# Why does the Promovierendenkonvent exist?

- One objective of the amendment of the Landeshochschulgesetzes (LHG) Baden-Württemberg in 2014 was to strengthen the position of the doctoral students
- Justification (translation of the German statement): *"As a group with its own interests, doctoral candidates have not yet had their own voice at universities. [...] A doctoral convention is therefore being set up to represent the interests of doctoral students and can make recommendations to the university bodies."*
- § 38 section 7 LHG: „Die **zur Promotion angenommenen** Doktorandinnen und Doktoranden bilden einen Konvent. [...]“ (*The doctoral candidates accepted for doctoral studies form a convention. [...]*)
